
#### Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Monday, March 18th to Tuesday, March 19th, 2024, among a sample of 1063 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in British Columbia. The survey was conducted using automated telephone interviews (Smart IVR). Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in British Columbia.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 3% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample. Totals may not add up 100% due to rounding.

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# If a provincial election were held today, how would you vote? (All voters)




